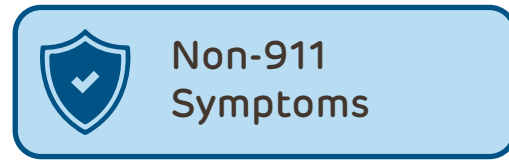
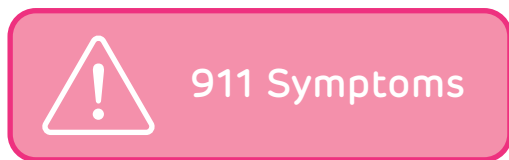
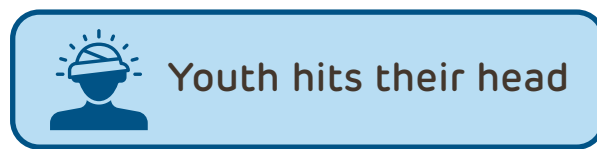
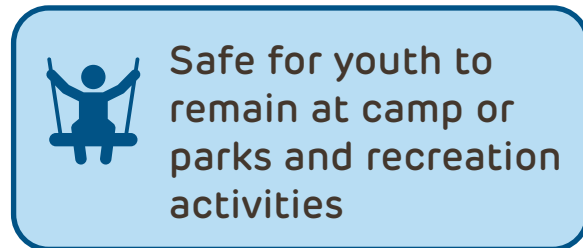


Head Injury Pathway



- Seizures (twitching or jerking movement of parts of the body; may look stiff)
- Weakness or tingling in the arms or legs
- Cannot recognize people or places
- Confused, restless or agitated
- Impaired consciousness
- Difficult to arouse or unable to awaken
- Repeated vomiting
- Slurred speech
- Bloody or clear fluid from the nose



- Remove youth from play
- Allow youth to engage in low-impact activities with low risk for further head impact
- Follow 2-point rule
